Interview with Matteo

What brought you to curling?

“Sport has always been a fundamental part of my life. Before a car accident, I competed in alpine skiing at a competitive level and was part of the Olympic team. After that event, I strongly felt the need to challenge myself again and continue competing. That’s how I discovered curling. I like it because it is a sport of concentration, tactics and strategy, and you need to deliver the stone with the greatest possible precision to reach the exact spot you want. It also allows you to meet new friends.”

What does this sport mean to you?

“Compared to skiing, which is an individual sport, curling helped me discover how engaging and motivating team play can be, where everyone tries to give their best for a shared victory. Having a clear role within a team has helped me grow a lot, both as an athlete and as a person.”

What does teamwork mean to you, in sport and at work?

“For me, curling represents teamwork in the most authentic sense of the word: mutual trust, continuous communication and shared responsibility. Everyone contributes individually, both at work and in sport, and the combined result creates strength and unity of purpose for the whole group through dialogue and mutual respect.” 🚀 🏆
